Most of the research on early adopters focuses on two self-identities that correspond to purchasing electric vehicles: 1) The environmentalist identity, and 2) The so-called car-authority identity. The environmentalist identity describes people with a pro-environmental orientation as part of their lifestyle and part of their self-image. The car-authority identity describes people who are experts on cars. These types of early adopters, the ones that are mainly technology-driven, don't really care about the environmental benefits of EVs. They mainly care about the technical attributes of the vehicles.
